#### **Committee Mandate**

- The BRC is appointed by the Board and is authorized to make recommendations as per board policy.
- The written recommendations of the BRC will be delivered to the Director of Education who will make them known to the Board of Trustees at a public meeting.
- While the BRC's establishment was triggered by the present circumstances, the future must be a primary component in considering the actions the BRC will recommend.



#### **Committee Mandate Continued**

- The BRC is encouraged, but not required, to come to consensus with respect to its recommendation(s).
- At all times the BRC should maintain its focus on the issue at hand and not allow itself to become distracted by side issues.
- The BRC will meet a minimum of two times.
- The Trustees will give the BRC's recommendations due consideration and they will decide on a course of action that best serves the needs of the Board.



#### **Review of Current School Situations**

- Two elementary schools with French Immersion and English programs.
- With the current situation a family could have students in two different schools
- Our Lady of Fatima has continued to maintain a significant student population. Lower class sizes and the addition of full day kindergarten means that space may become a concern.

# Review of Current School Situations Continued . . .

- Housing continues to be constructed in the Our Lady of Fatima area.
- The English program at Monsignor Uyen continues to decline (likely triple grades)
- Student space (OTG)
  - Monsignor Uyen 342 students (currently 258.5 students)
  - Our Lady of Fatima 425 students (currently 372 students)



### **Options Discussed**

- 1. Change boundaries to increase English stream enrolment at Monsignor Uyen
  - not a viable option as this is a short-term solution.
- Change boundaries to establish a single-stream French Immersion school and a single-stream English school. Considering the OTG capacities – OLOF 425 and Monsignor Uyen 342 – French Immersion single stream would be established at Monsignor Uyen.







#### Transition Plans for Students

- Who would benefit from a transition meeting?
  - Students identified as exceptional through IPRC
  - Students on IEP with extensive programming needs
  - Students who require a multi-disciplinary team approach
- Who attends the transition meeting?
  - School personnel involved with the student
  - Parents/Guardians
  - Community personnel that provide support to the child
  - Personnel from the receiving school



#### Transition Plans for Students

- What is discussed at the transition meeting?
  - Students strengths and areas of need
  - Successful programming practices as outlined in IEP
  - Transportation needs
  - Supports that need to be in place for child
  - Action items and follow-up meetings are established
  - Earlier transition meetings will occur
  - Orientation tour to new school may occur
- What about SEA equipment?
  - Ministry purchased SEA equipment transitions with the child to the receiving school
  - The SEA equipment transition will be coordinated between the Program Resource Teacher and the special education consultant responsible for Monsignor Uyen Catholic School and Our Lady of Fatima Catholic School



# CONSIDERATION OF OPTIONS



#### **OPTION 1**

#### Effective September 2012:

- all immersion students attend Monsignor Uyen Catholic School.
- All English students from Monsignor Uyen Catholic
   School transfer to Our Lady of Fatima Catholic School.



#### **OPTION 2**

#### Effective September 2012:

- all immersion students attend Monsignor Uyen Catholic School.
- English students from Monsignor Uyen Catholic School transfer to Our Lady of Fatima Catholic School, with the exception of current Grade 7 students who will be grandfathered to complete grade 8 at Monsignor Uyen.
