ST. CLAIR CATHOLIC OUTLINES FULL DAY KINDERGARTEN PROGRAM SITE SELECTION THROUGH SEPTEMBER 2014

The St. Clair Catholic District School Board has announced its full day kindergarten program site selections, through September 2014, when the program will be fully implemented at all schools across the entire system.

Full day kindergarten began in September 2010 and was gradually extended, as provincial funding became available, through a five year phase-in.

"We are pleased to announce our plans for full day kindergarten through year five of this provincial phase-in," says Paul Wubben, Director of Education. "Now families will know when the program will come to their Catholic school community and can make plans accordingly."
