

STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

The Student Support Services team for the St. Clair Catholic District School Board consists of Child and Youth Workers, Social Workers and Itinerant Behaviour Teachers.

The role of the Student Support Services team is to assist students by providing:

- Classroom or school-wide programming
- One to one counseling
- Small group instruction
- Support in a crisis situation

In addition, the team members work with school teams and parents to better understand and meet the behavioural, social and emotional needs of students.

Referral for services is initiated through the school principal.

Parental consent is necessary for students to work directly with a team member. Confidentiality is maintained in all matters.

In addition to meeting student needs, the team members assist in the school and in the school community by providing resources and in-services to staff and parents.

Child and Youth Workers provide direct intervention with students. They work in designated schools and assist school staff with assessing student behaviour and in developing plans that outline strategies to reinforce skill building and school success.

Social Workers assist schools, students and families in developing effective solutions to issues. They assist with the referral process to various community agencies. They also act as Attendance Counsellors.

The Itinerant Behaviour Teachers provide direct, shortterm intensive support for individual students and teachers.
