Dear Parents/Guardians,

I am writing today to make you aware that this evening, a certified asbestos abatement company will be contracted to remove VAT flooring tiles in Room 500, a staff room at Ursuline College.

VAT tiles contain non-friable asbestos, which means that during normal use no asbestos fibres are released into the environment.

The removal will be completed in compliance with all standards and legislated requirements, by *Canadian Industrial Specialties (CIS) Ltd. OH Solutions*, a Londonbased company with expertise in the field of environmental health and safety, has also been contracted to conduct air quality sampling after the abatement work has been completed. Removal work will not begin until this evening, after students and staff have left for the weekend; and the entire project will be completed before classes resume on Tuesday morning.
