TWO STUDENTS ELECTED TO THE POSITION OF STUDENT TRUSTEE FOR THE 2013—2014 SCHOOL YEAR

Two St. Clair Catholic secondary school students – one from Sarnia-Lambton and one from Chatham-Kent – have been elected to serve as Student Trustees for the 2013-2014 school year.

In order to be eligible, students must be Catholic, enrolled full-time in at least Grade 11, have access to transportation to attend meetings and have a record of good attendance.

Charlotte Stoesser will represent Sarnia-Lambton students; and Jocelyn McGlynn will represent students in Chatham-Kent. St. Christopher and St. Patrick's jointly selected the student trustee, in advance of next year's consolidation of the two campuses, in an election that was held on April 18. UCC held its student trustee election on April 19.
