An Evening with Dr. Terry Nelson-Johnson

A storyteller at heart, Terry Nelson-Johnson is an inspirational speaker, thought-provoking lecturer and energetic presenter. Through his stories, Dr. Nelson-Johnson takes people on what he describes as "treacherous adventures."

Often referred to as the Robin Williams of Catholicism, Terry is convinced that God is a contact sport and a living experience not merely an idea. Through his work, he believes mysteries are mysteries because they are infinitely accessible, and he implores audiences to enter more deeply into the mystery of grace, the mystery of spirit, the mystery of God.

Terry infuses presentations with humor bringing life to topics from Sexuality to Sacramental Preparation to Redemptive Intimacy. A doctor of theology, Terry interweaves scriptural references with current psychological readings, and keen insights from current events to captivate audiences while conveying important messages.

Audiences consistently award him high marks and many return noting the inspirational effect his stories and teachings have in their own spiritual development.
