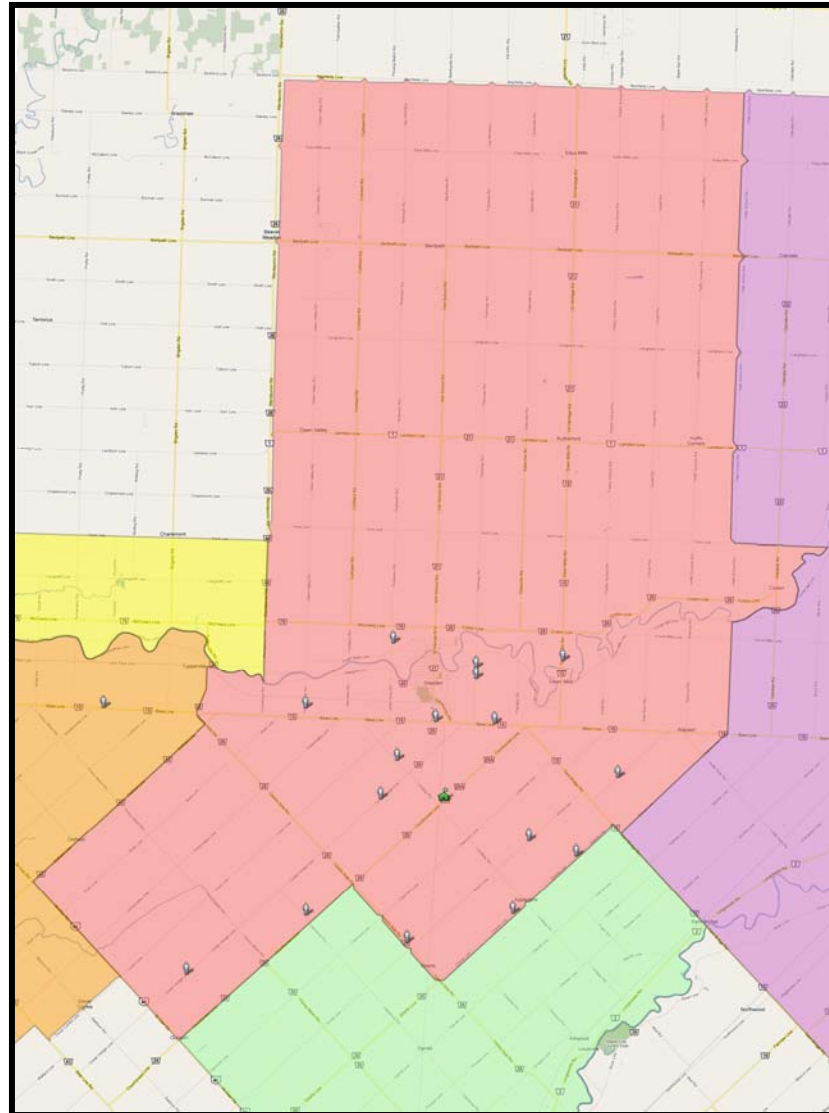
Policy 7.4 - Student Accommodation and Boundary Review

Administrative Procedures:

5.0 School Boundaries


- a) The Board establishes the boundaries for all schools within its jurisdiction.
- b) Boundaries will be reviewed and revisions recommended to trustees by administration, as circumstances warrant. The Board may consult with affected parents prior to setting new boundaries.
- c) Boundary changes will be communicated to parents/guardians who may be affected.


ST. MICHAEL TURNERVILLE BOUNDARIES

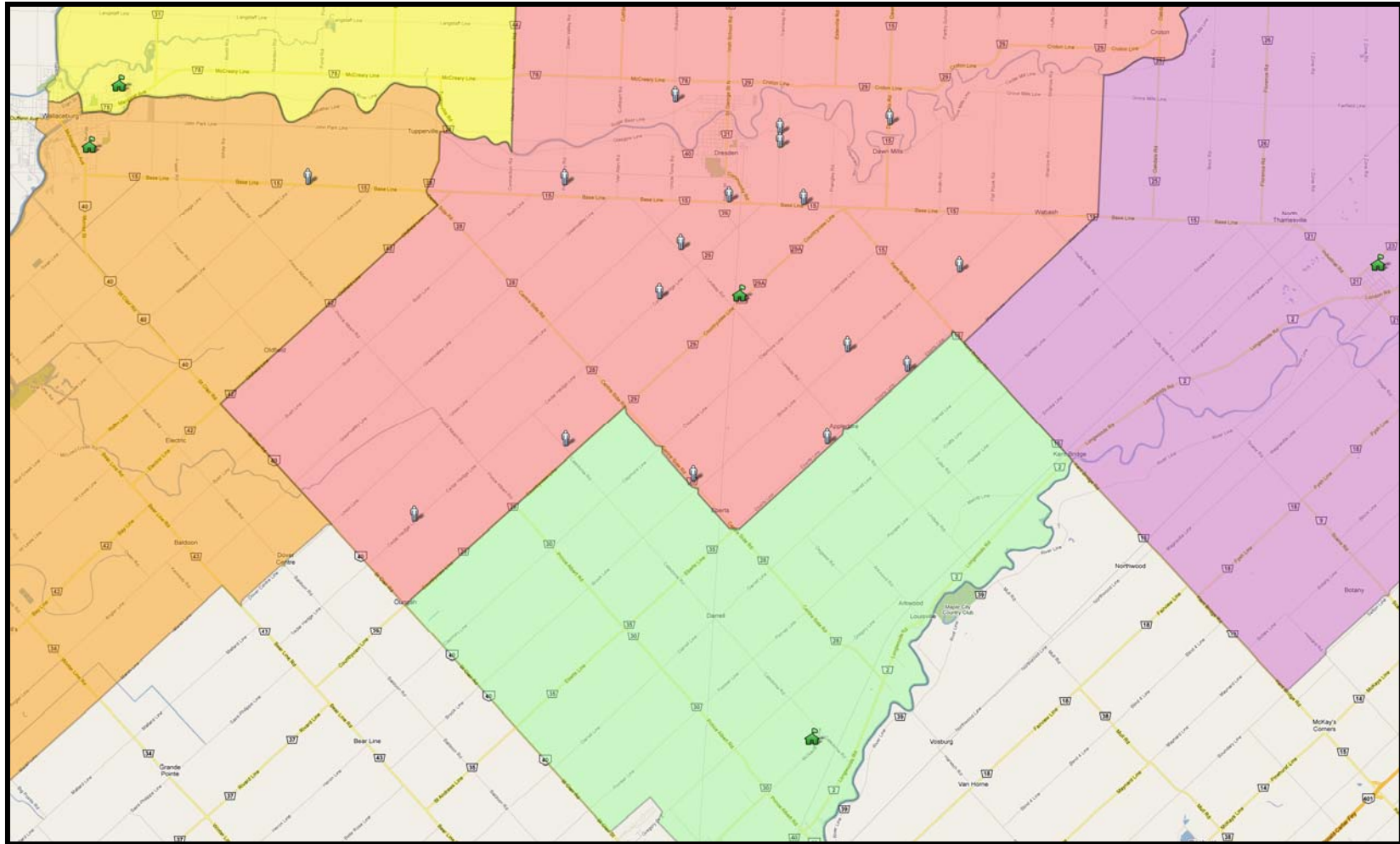


ST. MICHAEL TURNERVILLE STUDENT LOCATIONS AND SURROUNDING BOUNDARIES

ST. MICHAEL CATHOLIC SCHOOL BOUNDARIES

School boundaries bordering on St. Michael Turnerville:

- Good Shepherd, Thamesville
- St. Vincent, Chatham
- Holy Family, Wallaceburg
- Christ the King, Wallaceburg
- Sacred Heart, Port Lambton
- St. Philip, Petrolia

(currently no students between Kent Line and Aberfeldy Line attend St. Michael Catholic School)



ST. MICHAEL STUDENT DISTRIBUTION

Current distribution of grade 1-7 students
(39 students):

- 14 students reside in the Town of Dresden
- 24 students reside in the rural area
- 1 student resides outside the boundary area
